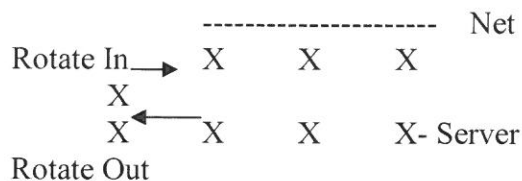

2017 Girls Volleyball Rules

Match Rules:

1. Match will consist of three games. All games will utilize rally scoring (a point is scored on every serve)
 - a. First two games will be played to 25 Must win by 2, or maximum of 27 points.
 - b. Third game will be played to 15 must win by 2, or maximum of 19 points **if time permits**.
2. All matches will begin with a coin toss, winner of the toss will choose to either serve first or what side of the court they will start on. In the following games serve and side will switch.
3. Six players maximum and 4 players minimum are on the court during the match
 - a. Players **MUST** rotate in and out of the game
 - b. Players will rotate off of the court from the back left position and rotate onto the court in the front left position. See diagram below (based on an 8 player team)
 - c. Rotation established at the start of the match will be utilized throughout the match
 - d. Teams rotate on every side out (the first rotation included)
 - e. Players will start the next game in the exact position they were in at the end of the previous game.



4. Serving can be done overhand or underhand and must be completed anywhere behind the black line at Jerusalem on both sides of the court, and at Coy the serve must be completed on the stage side behind the maroon line and on the wall side behind the big solid yellow line.
 - a. All players must be on the court at the time of the serve
 - b. Servers must wait for the signal from the official to serve. Signal will be either a whistle or a forward motion of their arm towards the net
 - c. After a player serves 5 consecutive points that team will maintain the serve but they will rotate one position and the new server will continue.
 - d. Net serves are still in play, provided they go over the net
 - e. Players tossing a ball to serve overhand have one time on each serve that they can throw and chose not to serve. If they don't like the toss the player should let the ball drop to the ground instead of catching.
 - f. **3rd & 4th Grade Only Players may serve from anywhere as long as they get the ball over.**
5. No player may touch the net while the ball is in play. If players from both sides hit the net simultaneously it is a double foul and the play will be done over.
 - a. No player may step completely across the center line of the court (on the line is legal)
 - b. Three hits maximum per team. A block does not count as a hit
 - c. No blocking of serves
 - d. Balls can be played off the ceilings or basketball hoops on your side of the court
 - e. Cannot be played off of the walls
 - f. If the ball hits any part of the line on the court the ball is in.
 - g. Nets shall be set at 6'8" for all matches
 - h. Roll the ball under the net between points
6. This is a **recreational developmental** league so players should attempt to hit the ball with a legal hit at all times. Officials will determine if a ball was carried or contacted illegally.
 - a. No underhand hits should be made with the palms; this will be counted as a carry.
 - b. All sets should be made with both hands simultaneously, and the palms can never touch the ball. The ball should not be caught.
 - c. Ball can be legally hit by all parts of the body above the waist provided only one contact is made.
7. For each game teams will have 1, one-minute timeout per game. Not cumulative for the match
8. Standings will **not** be kept for this league.
9. All coaches, parents, spectators and players are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsman like manner at all times.
