



Boys 5th and 6th Grade Basketball Program Information 2010



The Oregon Parks and Recreation and Jerusalem Recreation Departments would like to welcome you and your child to the 2010 basketball season. We hope you enjoy this season. Below are important dates that will guide you through the basketball season.

Program is only available to Oregon and Jerusalem Township residents. Open enrollment students are not eligible to participate.

Registration dates: Registration runs from November 30 to January 4. **If you register after teams are formed you will be placed on a waiting list and only placed on a team if there is an opening. The team you will be placed on will be the team with the lowest number, not necessarily the school you attend.**

Oregon and Jerusalem residents can register their children Monday through Friday 8:30 AM-5:00 PM at the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department. Please note the office will be closed on Dec 24, 25, 31 & Jan 1 and may have limited hours the week of Dec. 28.

To Register online become a member for **free**, if you have not already done so, then go under the programs registration tab, click on boys basketball program and proceed with the registration process.

Online you can pay with a credit card. If you pay at the office we only accept cash or check.

Oregon and Jerusalem residents can also register at the Jerusalem Township Hall located on Rt. 2 East of Oregon on the following dates: Saturday December 5th from 9:00 AM-11:00 AM and Mondays December 7th & 21st from 5:00 PM -7:00 PM

**The Oregon Recreation Department Office is not open during these times.
To register you must go to the Jerusalem Township Hall.**

Jerusalem residents can also drop off registrations and payment anytime utilizing the drop box located in the hallway just inside the front door of the township hall.

Registrations can also be mailed with a check made out to the City of Oregon at 5330 Seaman Rd. Oregon, OH 43616.

Uniform: Your child will receive a uniform that consists of a numbered T-shirt in the color of their team.

Evaluation Night: For Oregon/Jerusalem 6th Grade Boys only will be held on Tues. Jan 5. Coaches and Recreation department staff will be on hand to conduct drills and evaluate the boys. See below for times. Boys will report to the Eisenhower gym at the times indicated.

Fassett Boys: 6:30-7:30 PM

Eisenhower Boys: 7:30-8:30 PM

Coaches Meetings: The coaches' meeting will be held on Wed. Jan 6 at 7:00 PM in the Rec. office. Your child does not attend this meeting, just the coaches. **Coaches are needed for both ages and all schools!**

Games: Games will begin in January and conclude the first part of March. Games will be played at Fassett or Eisenhower Middle School Gyms. Games will be played on Saturdays and some nights during the week, based on coaches' and gym availability.
