



## Spring Soccer Program Information 2010



The Oregon Parks and Recreation and Jerusalem Recreation Departments would like to welcome you and your child to the 2010 Spring Soccer season. Soccer teams are divided by age, gender, and the school district the player resides in.

**Program is only available to Oregon and Jerusalem Township residents. Open enrollment students are not eligible to participate.**

Please note travel soccer players will not be able to participate in this league due to the time commitments of team games and team practices. **Also players who are participating in tier 2/travel baseball or softball teams may want to consider if the soccer program will fit with your schedule. The spring soccer season practices will begin in the middle of March with games starting in April and concluding the end of May weather permitting. Games will be held typically on the weekends. Oregon Tier 2 baseball games will begin the middle of May, with games during the week and the weekend. Tier 1 Baseball and Softball players will not have to worry about conflicts because Tier 1 games will not begin until the first of June after the spring soccer program.**

**Registration dates:** Registration runs from Feb. 1 until March 1. This is the deadline for registration. **If you register after this date you will be put on a waiting list and placed on a team only if there is an opening.**

**Please note children 10-14 years of age must sign up for the ESSL program as we have not had enough players to offer leagues in these age groups. By joining the ESSL it allows our older soccer players to compete against other communities and play 11 on 11 soccer.**

To register online, first become a member for free, then go under the program registration tab. Click the soccer program for your child's age and proceed with the registration process.

Online you can pay with a credit card. If you pay at the office we only accept cash or check.

Oregon and Jerusalem residents can register their children Monday through Friday 8:30 AM-5:00 PM at the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department **or** on the following dates at the **Jerusalem Township Hall:** Monday Feb. 8<sup>th</sup> from 5:00-7:00 PM and Saturday Feb. 20<sup>th</sup> from 10:00AM-12:00 PM

**Equipment:** Your soccer registration includes a soccer jersey with number and socks. Parents must provide shin guards for your youngster.

**Games:** Your child will play on either Saturday and/or Sunday each weekend. Weekday games will be played in the case of rainouts or to ensure the season will finish on time.

Please note in the U6, U8, and U10 age groups, teams will be formed and games will be played with either 6 or 8 players on the field depending on the number of player registered.

**Fall Tier 2 Soccer – Open to U8 players and above!**

This fall we will again be offering participants the option of playing soccer here at the Recreation complex in a house league as we have always had in the past or of playing in the East Suburban Soccer League (ESSL). This league is a recreation travel league. This means that you would not be playing all-star teams, but teams made up of individuals from a community. ESSL rules do not allow teams to form themselves but rather state that you must have a blind draw to divide teams. Their rules only allow for one head coach and one assistant coach per team and then the other players are divided up amongst the teams in each age group. The Oregon Recreation Department will work with the ESSL in an attempt to keep teams together by schools, as we do in our rec. programs.

Each team will have home games played here at the Rec. Soccer Complex and away games that will require you to travel to communities such as Northwood, Lake Township, Genoa, Eastwood, Oak Harbor and others.
