



NEW!! Eagles Basketball Association!!!!

The Oregon Parks and Recreation and Jerusalem Recreation Departments will be partnering with Dave Rodriguez (Clay HS basketball coach) to bring you the Eagles Basketball Association (EBA). This program will have four divisions for Pre-K & Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd grades, 3rd & 4th grades, and 5th & 6th grades. Pre-K/Kindergarten and 1st & 2nd grades will be co-ed teams. 3rd thru 6th grade teams will be separated into boys and girls teams. Girls team may play in the boys division if they choose to do so. Pre-K (**Must be 4yrs old as of Nov 3, 2019**) & Kindergarten division will use a 6 ft rim, 1st & 2nd grade division uses an 8 ft rim, and 3rd thru 6th grade uses 10 ft rim.

Program is open to Oregon residents, Jerusalem Township residents, and non-resident students enrolled in the Oregon Public School System or Cardinal Stritch Academy and Northwood(non-resident fee applies) students. (Please note a different fee structure is in place for eligible non-residents. See registration form for details.) Teams outside of Oregon that are already formed may partake in this league!!!!

Registration dates: Registration runs from Sept 19 to Oct 13. If you register after teams are formed, you will be placed on a waiting list and only placed on a team if there is an opening. The team you will be placed on will be the team with the lowest number, not necessarily the school you attend.

All eligible participants can register online at www.oregonohio.org/rec under “programs” or in the Rec Office. Office hours are 8 am- 4:30 pm, with lunch 12:30 pm – 1 pm.

Non Residents- All non-residents, whether attending Oregon City Schools or not, will **select the non-resident fee.**

Registration Fee Information: There is a fee structure on the registration form based on residency and free and reduced lunch program. *Stritch does not cover this fee.* There is a \$10 late fee if you register after the deadline but before the clinic on Nov. 3. After the clinic, you will be placed on a waiting list. We will look at the teams to see if there is room on a team for your child. If there is room on a team, the late fee will be \$20, and your child will be placed on the team with the least amount of players regardless of school.

Uniforms: Each athlete will be provided with a reversible jersey and short set.

Games: Games will begin **November 17 and end in January 2020.** Season will conclude with a tournament. Games will be played on **Sundays** at **Clay High School gymnasium.** Practice times will be based on coaches’ and gym availability. There will be a **clinic on Sunday Nov. 3** at Clay HS to assess players to assist in fairly forming teams. This clinic is not mandatory, but is **STRONGLY** recommended.

Interested in Coaching?? Submit information on the registration. Teams will be formed after the Nov. 3 clinic, and a **coaches meeting** will be held **Mon. Nov 4 at 6pm** at Oregon Rec offices. Rosters/teams will finalized at coaches meeting. Coaches from outside teams are encouraged to attend as rules and game play will be discussed at this meeting.
