

### **T-Ball Program Information 2020**



Welcome to the 2020 T-Ball season. The Oregon Parks and Recreation Department along with Jerusalem Twp. Recreation offers a progression of programs to maximize your child's involvement and development in baseball & softball.

Registration begins on May 19 and will continue until May 31, 2020. Subject to change due to Covid-19 situation.

Program is open to Oregon residents, Jerusalem Township residents, and non-resident students enrolled in the Oregon Public School System or Cardinal Stritch Academy. (Please note a different fee structure is in place for eligible non-residents. See registration form for details.)

Eligible non-residents enrolled in the Oregon Public Schools system or Cardinal Stritch Academy for the 2019-2020 school year may be asked for proof of enrollment.

All eligible participants can register at the Oregon Parks and Rec. office Mon-Fri. 8:00-4:30 PM. OR at <a href="www.oregonohio.org/rec.">www.oregonohio.org/rec.</a> To register online, click on the "Program" tab. Make sure you choose the correct fee type.

Games will begin the first week of June and will be played on Sunday afternoons with one to two practices during the week. There may also be weeknight games to ensure the season is concluded by the end of July.

This program is for kids entering kindergarten in the fall of 2020. Kids currently in kindergarten will play coach pitch. Please complete their registration on a coach pitch form.

Players will be divided into teams by school districts and will have the opportunity to play approximately 8-10 games. Teams will have a volunteer coach who will work with the players to develop their baseball/softball skills, teach them the basics of playing the sport, and help them to play as a team. Parents are encouraged to become involved and help the coaches with this process. Program cost includes a shirt, hat, and the opportunity to participate.

- ➤ All players must provide their own helmet. Helmet must meet NOCSAE standards.
- ▶ Please register early. This year a \$10.00 late fee will be charged if you register after the deadline but before the team selection. After the team selection the late fee will be \$20.00, also after the team selection players will be placed on the team with the smallest number regardless of school. This is due to the fact that the Rec. is charged for uniform rush orders and the extra steps needed to process the late registration.

Coaches are needed for all ages and programs. Please CALL the Recreation Department know in advance if you are interested. This helps us to determine how many coaches we need to recruit. This also allows the coach to be involved in all aspects of background checks, certifications, training, team selection and rules meetings.

No coaches meeting. Teams will be pre-selected. Coach and ONE assistant coach can have their children on their rosters.

# ORec Summer 2020 Sports/COVID changes

## \*\*\*\*\*Please be certain to read and adhere to the following\*\*\*\*

- 1. **Schedule**. We will be starting baseball/softball/Tball games starting June 26 and run through last week of July. We will try to schedule at least 8 games. If you have decided that you are not comfortable with your child playing or do not want to partake and have already registered, PLEASE let us know immediately so we can process your refund.
- 2. **UNIFORMS**. We will going with a ballcap, shirt and athletic mask for ALL leagues. We have to keep this as simple and smooth as possible and do not see a fitting/sizing for the 9-10 yr old baseball/softball players would be practical from a "no contact, social distancing" standpoint. The uniform cost will be the same as originally stated on T-ball, coach Pitch, and modified kid pitch registrations. However, the 9-10 baseball/softball uniform cost was originally a bit more. Therefore, anybody who already registered for 9-10 baseball/softball prior to the COVID postponement and wishes to still play will receive a refund for the difference of the uniform cost.
- 3. **Team selection/Coach meeting**. Please CALL IMMEDIATELY 419-698-7147 if you want to coach. We need to fill these roles ASAP. For this season the ORec staff will be forming teams. Each head coach and ONE assistant coach will get to have their children on their team. ALL OTHER players will be assigned by the ORec staff. After teams are formed, we will either have a virtual meeting with coaches or post an informative video to reiterate what is expected of them for the season.
- 4. Go to **oregonohio.org/rec** under "**forms**" and print out the **Ohio Department of Health Responsible Restart protocol**. We will be STRICTLY adhering to the MANDATORY guidelines. No exceptions. We will have staff on hand to monitor at games/practices to make sure these rules are followed.
